HOW TO PROPAGATE SUCCULENTS IN 8 EASY STEPS



STEP 1

Gather supplies:

- Succulent plant
- Cactus or succulent soil
- Shallow Dish
- Spray Bottle filled with water
- Planter pot



STEP 2:

1. Remove leaves from the succulent plant by twisting off the leaf from its base. Aim to make a clean break from the stem.





STEP 3:

Place cuttings away from direct sunlight for 2-3 days or until callouses form over the base of the leaf.

STEP 4:

Fill the shallow dish with soil.

STEP 5:

Place succulents leaves on top of the soil gently pressing the base of each leaf into the soil.

STEP 6:

Use the spray bottle to water to water the succulents.

*Use a spray bottle to water in order to avoid overwatering which can cause the plants to rot.







STEP 7: After 45-65 days the succulents can be transplanted.

STEP 8: Re-plant in pot of your choice and enjoy!
